A preliminary investigation revealed that Jayavarman, who owned and operated a popular youth hostel in Anchorage and who has dual citizenship in the U.S. and Cambodia, had made at least a dozen such trips between 2010 and his arrest in 2013. During that time, it was later learned, he produced videos of himself having sex with a child
