The John Winton House was built in 1812. It was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2003.

Before 1785, one of the earliest settlers in the Martel area was John Winton and wife, Arabella Cunningham Winton. The Wintons left Virginia about 1784 and moved first to Jefferson County. John Winton (born November 8, 1761) left the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia soon after he married Arabella Cunningham. When John Winton heard Methodist Bishop Francis Asbury preach, they became friends. For lack of a minister, he began as a layman to preach and was ordained by

Bishop Asbury as a deacon and Methodist elder in 1800. John and Arabella Winton first built an arbor and campground at Muddy Creek and hundreds came to the outdoor services and revivals.

The center of John Winton's holdings, or the home place, was located at Muddy Creek Station, a stage coach stop, on the waters of Muddy Creek, now Martel Community, in Lenoir City, Tennessee.
