Since Washington high school students Field Office (WFO) nual Future Agents in Training (FAIT) program, which provides a hands-on approach to educating area high school juniors and seniors on the Bureau's operations. With a focus on becoming a special agent, the program presents a cross section of the FBI, including its criminal, counterterrorism, intelligence, and administrative divisions.

"The high school students who attend the FAIT program are among the best and the brightest from our region," said WFO Assistant Director in Charge Paul Abbate. "While youth today are exposed to stories about law enforcement in the news and on dramatic television shows, the program provides a realistic, behind-thescenes look into life in the FBI."

This year, a stop at the Explosives Unit range was included in the week's curriculum. Students learned how the unit investigates bombings and responds to suspicious packages. Various stations were set up to display equipment and technology, while live demonstrations were
