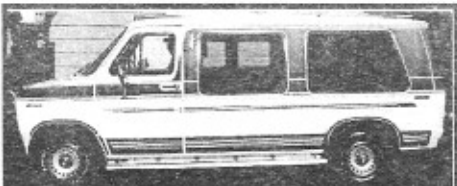

Elbert Greg Russell, 42, Axley Chapel Road, Greenback, was charged with driving while license suspended.

Don Scott Criss, 53, Cedar Lane, Vonore, was charged with public intoxication.

According to records the arrests came after Deputy Chris Bowen, with assistance from Deputy Daniel Kelly, LCSD responded to a residence along Shaw Ferry Road in response to an individual with a gun who was with two other persons in a black Jeep Liberty. Lisa Edsell was found in the front passenger seat of the Jeep, which was registered to her, with Elbert Russell behind the wheel and Don Criss in the back seat.

At least four witnesses told the officers Edsell was kicking on the door of the home and threatening the occupants with a gun, stating to them that she wanted her

money or her dope.

Upon placing the trio in the patrol car, Edsell's purse was searched for the weapon and the lawmen found a plastic bag containing approximately 13 grams of a white powder substance believed to be cocaine. The weapon was located in a plastic bag on the floorboard of the vehicle within Edsell's reach and was identified as a Fie snub nose .22 caliber revolver. Police seized the Jeep and \$116 in cash from Edsell.

Criss was placed under arrest for public intoxication and Russell for driving on suspended license. All three were transported the Loudon County Correctional Facility just after 2:30 p.m. Sunday.
