

## Wrecker driver charged with hindering creditors in auto scam

A Knoxville wrecker driver who works for a company called Sam's Wrecker Service has been apprehended at his place of employment after warrants were issued by LCSD and LCPD alleging the man bought cars and then changed the titles and sold the cars again.

According to the warrant filed by Investigator Chris White, LCSD CID; on or about December 12, 2006 John Mathew Bailey did purchase a 1996 Chevy pickup from Walt Williams in

about March 7, 2007 Bailey had Title Max removed as the lien holder and pawned the title at Tennessee Title Loans.

John Matthew Bailey, 27, of Graves Street, Knoxville, was charged with three counts of hindering secured creditor. Deputy Chris Bowen LCSD made the arrest at Sam's Automotive in Knoxville. Detective Jonathan Sartin, LCPD made the arrest at Loudon County Jail.
