Loudon Police officer fired following arrest for burglary, 2nd man also charged

According to sources a part-time Loudon City Police Officer has been fired following his arrest on a slew of burglary charges in neighboring Monroe County.


LPD sources report that Steve Robert Gutt, 24, was hired in April by LPD on a "work as needed" basis.

Monroe County Sheriff's deputies took Gutt into custody after an unnamed ment Chief James Webb source gave them information on 30 burglaries committed in Monroe County, any further comment.

Deputies obtained search warrants for three residences in Monroe County and arrested Steve Gutt and 44-year-old Hubert Elam Thursday.

Each man has been charged with 23 counts of aggravated burglary and one count of theft over \$1000.


