

Be careful who you meet on the Equipment internet, romance ends in battery stolen

A Lenoir City woman fell victim to a man she met on the internet and was fortunate to escape with her life after being smothered with a pillow.

According to the warrant for aggravated sexual battery filed by Detective Jonathan Sartin, LCPD; on December 10, 2008 at approximately 12:49am Carson Matthew Jones did, while at the victims residence commit the offense. After she was able to push him off he grabbed a pillow, put it over her face and Jones tried to remove her pants. The victim further stated she almost passed out but was able to bite Jones fingers until he started bleeding. The victim stated Jones then got off and grabbed his belongings and left. This action did place the victim in fear of serious bodily injury and or death.

The warrant also noted the victim and Jones have been having a relationship for approximately 2 weeks after meeting on the internet.

In two other warrants, filed by Detective Jack Fine, LCPD: on December 10, 2008 at approximately 9:23am Carson Jones did initiate a report to law enforcement concerning an offense that did not occur and knowing the information he provided was false. Jones told Officer Dennis Guider he had been robbed. Jones further reported a false identity as well.

Carson Matthew Jones, 47, of Laws Hollow Road, Petros, was charged with identity theft, false report and aggravated sexual battery.

Deputy Chris Bowen ,LCSD made the arrest at the Morgan County Jail.

to the leg. The victim and his wife both told the officer he was wiping down the gun when he dropped it. The man stated when it hit the floor the weapon discharged and shot him in the left calf. He wrapped the wound and got the bleeding to stop in just a few minutes.

The man decided he was hurt bad enough to seek medical attention. The gun was a two shot Davis Arms Derringer, 32 caliber. The bullet was a round nose and made a clean pass-through entry and exit wound to the calf.

A doctor at Fort Loudoun ER recommended the victim be transported to UT Hospital for further care. No other information was available at the time of the report.

lease for this house, which is owned by Mr. Lee Guetterman. They were not allowed to have pets there, but the caregiver got several cats and dogs that she kept at the residence. She was told to put up a deposit for the animals but she never did.

After some other events happened and Mr. Reynolds, seeing the condition of the house, the caregiver was fired. She was supposed to be out by Sunday. It wasn't until Wednesday that she finally moved out.

When Mr. Reynolds went to assess the damages to the house he observed the caregiver loading

the last of her things and noticed a rug strapped to the top of her van. He didn't think anything about it until he got inside to see there were things missing from the residence and it was then that Mr. Revnolds remembered the rug strapped to the top of the van belonged to one of the handicapped ladies.

The missing items were described as a 32 inch television and a breathing machine belonging to one of the ladies and a microwave and the rug belonged to the other

A refrigerator was also stolen. It belonged to the home owner.

Damages to the residence included

the carpet in the doorways of the bedrooms, which had been chewed up by an animal. Two rows of siding on the back side of the house had been removed and someone made carvings all over the foam backing. The outside of the garage in the back yard had a large size hole all the way through from where the caregiver's son reportedly ran a vehicle into the garage.

The estimated damages to the residence is approximately \$7000.
