



A Special Called Meeting of the Loudon County Commission will be held on Monday, March 24, 2008. The Commission will consider and vote on a proposal by Malibu Boats, LLC asking the County to consent to an assignment by Malibu Boats of a lease executed by the County on November 1, 2005, an easement granted by the County on January 9, 1997, and a temporary easement granted by the County on November 4, 2005. Malibu Boats proposes to sell and immediately lease back property at 5075 Kimberly Way, Loudon, Tennessee 37774, which includes the land leased from the County and on which Loudon County granted and easement allowing Malibu Boats the right to use parking areas, a boat ramp and a gravel drive located on County property for the purpose of its boat testing operations, and an additional easement allowing Malibu Boats the right to grade certain County property for its benefit. Malibu Boats proposes that Spirit Master Funding IV, LLC acquire the 5075 Kimberly Way property and the existing lease from the County, and Spirit Masters Funding IV, LLC will sublease the property back to Malibu Boats, including the easements, for an initial term of twenty years, with three ten-year extensions. The current lease for the benefit of Malibu Boats is recorded at Book Number T826, Pages 397-405. The current easements for the benefit of Malibu Boats are recorded at Deed Book Number 230, Pages 807-809 and Deed Book Number 303, Pages 29-33 at the Loudon County Register's Office. Neither the lease nor the easements can be assigned without written consent of Loudon County, and in order to give such consent, the County Commission must pass a resolution approving those assignments. The County Commission will meet at 6:00 p.m. on March 24, 2008, at the Loudon County Office Building, 100 River Road. Loudon, Tennessee 37774.





Collaborative effort LCSD Narcotics, CSI, LCPD to take down duo in bust

At approximately 7pm the Loudon County Sheriff's Department Narcotics unit along with LCPD served a search warrant on West 5th avenue. Lenoir City in an apartment. Sgt. Billy Hall, and Investigator Adam Yokley, along with Officer Jason Butler served the warrant and they observed numerous clear plastic bags containing a white powder substance believed to be cocaine, approximately 25 grams through the bedroom Wilmar Robin Del Valle resides in.

Officers also observed several clear plastic bags containing a green plant material believed to be marijuana, approximately 25 grams in Del Valle's bedroom.

While searching the room of Roberto Cano a set of digital scales was discovered under the bed. Found above the closet in a cabinet was a green duffel bag with approximately 68 grams of marijuana. Found in the closet was approximately 30 grams of a white powder substance believed to be cocaine. Found under the bed was another bag of marijuana that weighed approximately 17 grams.

to the scene to handle the processing of evidence and for further investigative purposes.
