He also holds seats on the House Committee on Natural Resources, which retains jurisdiction over national parks and natural resources, and the House Committee on Oversight

and Government Reform.

Steve Gill is host of Tennessee's most influential radio talk show. "The Steve Gill Show" airs on WLAC in Nashville as well as nearly a dozen other stations across the state. He is also the Chief Political Analyst for WKRN News 2 (ABC) in Nashville, and makes frequent appearances as a political commentator on Fox News, CNN,

MSNBC and other media outlets in the U.S. and abroad. Talkers magazine has repeatedly recognized Gill among the "100 Most Important Talk Radio Hosts in America" and Business Tennessee has named him among the "100 Most Powerful People in Tennessee" for four straight years. He has received numerous AIR (Achievement in Radio) awards, including Best Talk Host in Nashville, and was twice recognized as a "Hero of the Taxpayers" by Americans for Tax Reform for his leadership in opposing a state income tax.

As a lawyer, businessman, and government official, Gill has traveled extensively around the world, visiting more than a dozen countries in Europe, Asia, South America, and the Middle East. Gill served on the adjunct faculty of Belmont University from 1991 to 2004, teaching international business and negotiation.

In 1992 he was appointed to a White

House Fellowship by President George H.W. Bush and served as Director of Intergovernmental Affairs for the U.S. Trade Representative in the Executive Office of the President. There, Gill worked with governors and state officials as a primary liaison on international trade policy.

Gill has been a contributing editor for Tennessee Business magazine, a legal columnist for Advantage magazine, and publishes a weekly column in a dozen newspapers across the state. He co-authored "Tennessee Environmental Law" (Federal Publications, 1992) and wrote The Fred Factor: How Fred Thompson May Change the '08 Elec-

tion (MCN Publishing, 2008).

Gill received both his undergraduate degree (Honors History) and his law degree from the University of Tennessee, where he played varsity basketball on the 1977 SEC championship team. He was president of the Student Body, president of Omicron Delta Kappa, and student member of the Board of Trustees.

We are unsure where the they finished in the race but they did indeed finish ahead of a lot of other people.

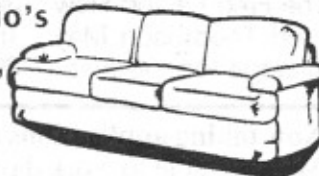

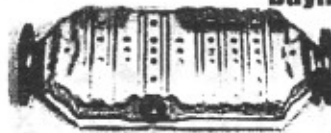
