A Lenoir City man was apprehended by LCPD Sgt. Joe Foster after the man was found to have been involved in three separate accidents and took off without reporting them, causing damage to vehicles in his path and with no regard for his own 10 year old child he had in the car with him.

According to the Loudon County warrants, on June 23, 2008 Deputy Marty Stanley, was dispatched to the area of Lenoir City on a complaint of a subject yelling and threatening people as he drove by. As Deputy Craig Brewer and Deputy Stanley were leaving the area of the complaint a call came out that a

A few minutes later the vehicle was found wrecked at the intersection of Old Midway Road and Oakley Glen Road. The driver of the vehicle was found a short distance away in a yard on Shaw Ferry Road. The driver was identified as Jeffery J. Morrison and he had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his person and did admit to driving the vehicle with his 10-year-old son in the vehicle.

A check through NCIC showed his license to be suspended for failure to satisfy a citation out of Knox County. 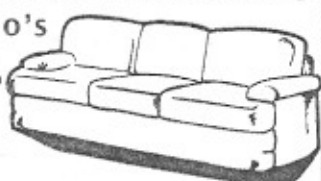

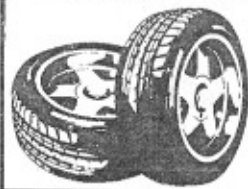

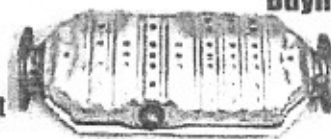
