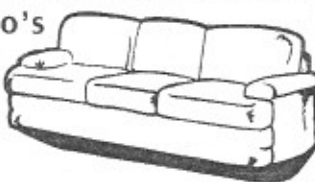

he had broken the victims cell phone. Deputy Chris Bowen, LCSD made the arrest.














