Cops crack down on crack, alleged dealers busted

Narcotics charge man with sell and deliver of crack cocaine

According to the warrant, filed by Investigator A.J. Yokley, LCSD Narcotics Division; on April 24, 2008 at approximately 8pm the Loudon County Sheriff's Department Office Narcotics Unit met with a confidential informant to conduct a controlled buy to purchase crack cocaine from the Riverview Road Community area.

Narcotics nabs another in crack cocaine bust

According to the warrant, filed by Sgt. Billy Hall, LCSD Narcotics Division (ND); on July 9, 2008 the Loudon County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Division purchased crack cocaine in the amount of not less than .01 gram and not more than 5 grams from Claiborne Clay White via a controlled buy using a confi-

The informant was wired with audio and video recording devices and sent into the Newton Road area.

During the course of the buy Jeremy L. Kerr did exchange three small white rock

like substance believed to be crack cocaine for US currency. The buy was monitored by officer via audio equipment.

The TBI lab report showed the rocks were cocaine base and weighed approximately .1 grams.

Jeremy Lamont Kerr, 31 of Newton Road, Lenoir City was charged with sell and delivery of schedule II (crack cocaine). Investigator AJ Yokley LCSD ND made the arrest and filed the charges.

White

denial informant who was wired with audio and video recording equipment and given US Currency to purchase crack cocaine from Claiborne Clay White.

White was in the Riverview Community and the informant was followed to the Riverview Community and monitored during the transaction via a transmitting device.

The informant left the Riverview Community and was followed to an undisclosed location where the informant turned over crack cocaine that was purchased from Claiborne Clay White.

While reviewing the recording from the controlled buy, LCSD Narcotics In-

vestigators witnessed the transaction take place between the informant and Claiborne Clay White.

On July 11, 2008 the ND purchased crack cocaine from White in the same manner as the first buy and it also was recorded.

Claiborne Clay White, 48, of Highland Avenue, Lenoir City was charged with sell and delivery of schedule II (crack cocaine).

Sgt. Billy Hall, LCSD ND filed the charges. Investigator AJ Yokley, LCSD ND made the arrest.

Johnson

19, 2008 the ND met with a confidential informant to purchase crack cocaine and hydrocodone pills from Mary Ann Johnson at her residence on Cedar Park Drive via a controlled buy.

The informant was wired with audio and video surveillance equipment and followed to the buy location.

During the course of the buy Mary Ann Johnson exchanged crack cocaine and

5 pills for US Currency. The buy was monitored by officers and the TBI report revealed the substance was cocaine base and hydrocodone pills.

In another warrant, on May 13, 2008 the ND made a controlled buy of crack cocaine from Mary Ann Johnson, also using a confidential informant.

At the residence at the time Johnson was taken into custody was Joshua Paul Wright and he was found to have an outstanding warrant out of Lenoir City and when searched was found to have a Suboxone pill he had no prescription for.

Mary Ann Johnson, 56, of Cedar Park Drive, Lenoir City was charged with sell and delivery of schedule II crack cocaine x2 and sell and delivery of schedule III (hydrocodone).

Joshua Paul Wright, 28, of Cedar Park Drive, Lenoir City, was charged with possession of schedule III (suboxone). Sgt. Billy Hall, LCSD made the arrests.

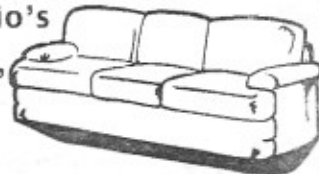

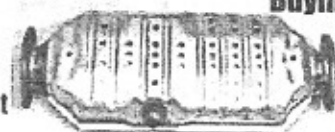
