

The event took place at Grave's residence on Jackson Bend Road in Loudon County.

The confidential informant was wired with audio and video recording equipment and given U.S. currency to purchase Hydrocodone pills from Rhonda Graves at her residence on Jackson Bend Road and monitored during the transaction via a transmitting device.

The informant left Graves' house and was followed to an undisclosed location

where the informant turned over the pills that were purchased from Graves.

While reviewing the recording from the controlled buy ND investigators witnessed a drug transaction take place between the informant and Rhonda Graves

Rhonda Gina Graves. 37, of Jackson Bend Road, Greenback, was charged with sell and delivery of schedule III narcotics. Deputy TJ Scarbrough, LCSD made the arrest.


