1.5 Million Turn to 511 for Statewide Traffic Information

Nashville, TN – More than 1.5 million people have called Tennessee 511 for information since the program launch in August 2006. On August 25, 2008 at around 6:33 p.m. eastern time the 1,500,000th caller dialed 511 for motorist information.

Drivers in Tennessee have been using Tennessee 511 in increasing numbers since TDOT launched the system in 2006. In addition to real-time traffic information on Tennessee's interstate and state highways, travelers can access weather condi-
