Chrest's lived on Inata Circle in Loudon.


Mr. Hensley states on February 5th, 2008. \$20.368.10 was used from the \$38,000 check to pay a hardware store in Lenoir City. He advised the money was used for two houses not being built by Mr. Hensley, for general accounts belonging to Mr. Chrest and for a deck being built at Mr. Chrest's house. The value of the theft is is estimated at \$80,000.

This case is under investigation.




