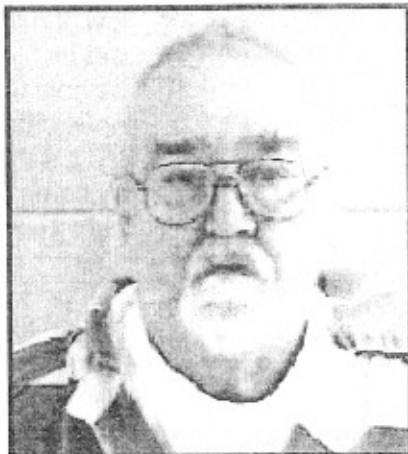

never finished and First National Bank foreclosed on them.

Mr. Hensley also hired the Chrest's to finish seven cabins near Wears Valley.

Hensley stated he wrote two checks, one for \$38,000 and another for \$8000 for invoices that were never received from the Chrest's.

The man advised his bank contacted him and stated vendors were going to file liens against him. Hensley further stated the money given to Mr. Chrest was used to make other purchases.

Mr. Hensley advised the checks written to 'Chrest Built Homes' and individually to Robert Chrest totaled approximately \$80,000.

During the time of the transactions the

Chrest's lived on Inata Circle in Loudon.

Mr. Hensley states on February 5th, 2008, \$20,368.10 was used from the \$38,000 check to pay a hardware store in Lenoir City. He advised the money was used for two houses not being built by Mr. Hensley, for general accounts belonging to Mr. Chrest and for a deck being built at Mr. Chrest's house. The value of the theft is estimated at \$80,000.

This case is under investigation.

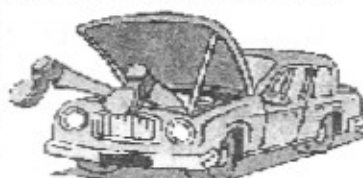

of the money and send the rest back. The man did cash the checks at the Sun Trust Bank in Lenoir City. He advised upon cashing the checks he did send the mon-

ey back to the sender via Western Union.

Mr. Locher stated soon after cashing the checks he received a notice from his bank stating the checks were not good and

in fact were false accounts.

Sgt. Upton advised Mr. Locher this practice is commonly used to defraud people. The total value of the loss is \$13,800
