hand lane and it crossed the white line and the yellow line, running into the emergency lane several times.

The vehicle turned onto Trigon Road and Deputy Goddard activated his emergency equipment and the vehicle did not stop. Webb performed poorly on sobriety tasks and gave insufficient samples for a BAC at the jail.

According to the report, early Wednesday morning at 12:56 a.m. Officer Mike Hodges, LCPD observed a white 2000 Cadillac Deville driving east bound on Broadway near Highway 321.

The driver, identified as

Robert Carl Spalding, allegedly straddled the center line for about 80 yards. He came to a complete stop in the middle of the road while the light was green at the intersection of Broadway and Highway 321.

While talking to the man, Officer Hodges noticed his speech was slurred and he was very slow to respond to the officer's questions. He also performed poorly on field sobriety tasks.

When asked to submit to a chemical test to determine his blood alcohol level Spalding reportedly refused.

session of marijuana for resale, possession of schedule II & III for resale, unlawful possession of a firearm by a convicted felon and possession of drug paraphernalia. According to the warrants, on March 18, 2009 at approximately 2:30pm The LCSO Criminal Investigation Division (CID) and Narcotics Division (ND) served a search warrant on Beals Chapel Road at the home of Danny and Daniel Poe. While searching the garage area of the home approximately 13 ounces of marijuana and over 400

hydrocodone pills were located in the trunk of a vehicle inside the garage. The marijuana was packaged in several different bags and in several different weights. The hydrocodone was packaged in several different packages and in different amounts.

Also found in the trunk area was 2 oxycodone pills, US Currency, Danny Poe's social security card, scales, plastic bags and other items of value. Found in Danny Poe's bedroom was a safe containing 5 handguns, 3 of which were loaded, along with marijuana

na and scales. Also found in the bedroom was boxes of plastic bags used to package marijuana and digital scales used to weigh marijuana for resale. Danny Poe is a convicted felon and has served several years in prison for drug offenses.

Sgt. Billy Hall LCSO ND made the arrest and filed the charges. Also assisting in the investigation were Detective Lt. Jeff Vittatone, Detective Jason Smith, LCSO CID; Sgt. Detective Patrick Upton, LCSO CID, Detective Charles Cosner, LCSO CID and Investigator AJ Yokley, LCSO ND.

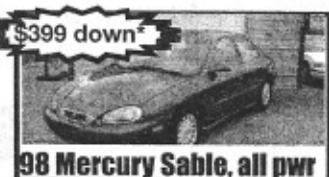

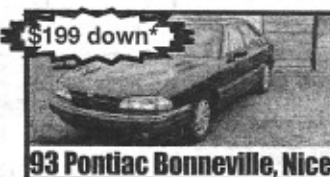

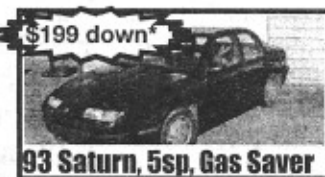
