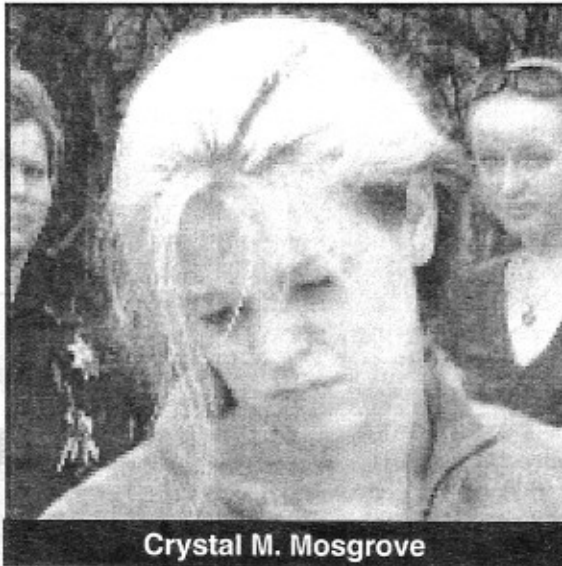
## Charges keep coming for local woman

A Lenoir City woman who reportedly had to be stopped by the ramming of a police car on Broadway Thursday has received an additional charge in connection with that incident and was charged with DUI in connection with a December 2008 accident in which she reportedly tested positive for multiple drugs, as well as alcohol.

Crystal M. Mosgrove, 21, Get Good Hollow Road, Loudon was charged with aggravated assault.

According to records, Friday at 9:00 a.m. Detective Jack Fine, LCPD took a statement from a woman who lives on C Street in Lenoir City. According to

her, she heard a light knock on her front door at approximately 1:20 p.m. on Thursday. She opened the curtain to see who it was and saw Crystal Mosgrove and heard her say "I'm lost can you help me?"

The woman also reported she saw someone with their back to the door wearing a black head mask. She advised she knew the voice to be Crystal's and had prior knowledge Crystal Mosgrove had broken into her house prior to this day, so she called 911.

The woman looked out the window again and saw Ms. Mosgrove running off the porch with a shotgun in her hand. That placed the woman in fear of her and her children's life.

Mosgrove was further charged with DUI 1st by drugs or alcohol.

According to a warrant, on December 16, 2009, Corporal Chad Estes and Deputy Steve Helm, LCSO, were dispatched to a wreck with injury on Get Good Hollow Road and upon arrival

found Mosgrove behind the wheel of a 92 Honda Hatchback.

The corporal reported Mosgrove had slurred speech, red, glassy eyes and a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage was coming from her vehicle. While trying to ascertain what had caused the accident, Mosgrove stated she was trying to kill herself by hitting the brick mailbox in front of her residence with her vehicle.

The lawman further reported he asked Mosgrove if she had been taking any prescription medication and she said she had taken some oxycontin, but she didn't have a prescription for it, she bought it on the street.

Due to Mosgrove's injuries she was not administered field sobriety tasks, but she consented to a blood and urine test at the hospital. The sample was sent to the TBI crime lab and came back positive for amphetamine, amitriptyline, nortriptyline, oxycodone and alcohol, which was .04%.
