## What's the deal with using vehicles in domestic violence?

In two completely separate events, two people were charged with aggravated assault by domestic violence after using their vehicles as weapons toward their victims.

### McGhee Square resident charged in aggravated assault in Loudon

According to the report, Officer April Farmer, LPD received a domestic call from Carding Machine Road in Loudon and spoke with the victim who stated he and Malina Nanette Smith had gotten into an argument at her store on Mulberry Street in Loudon. According to the report, Deputy Michael Watkins, LCSO was dispatched to a possible drunk driver on Highway 11 around 10:36 p.m. Deputy Watkins spotted a gold Ford Thunderbird matching the description of the vehicle on Highway 11 near Patty Well Drilling.

The vehicle was reportedly across the right hand line and was impeding traffic by traveling less than 10 mph.

The deputy turned around and attempted to make a traffic stop when the vehicle turned onto Highland Park Drive. The vehicle was still traveling at around 10 mph and on the wrong side of the roadway. It finally came to a stop near Robinson Drive.

The driver, Ivan Garcia had bloodshot eyes and a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his person. He reportedly stated he'd had three beers.

Garcia was very belligerent and advised Deputy Watkins "he did not care" when asked if he understood field sobriety and refused to do any tasks.

There were two open Budweiser cans with beer inside in the vehicle.

Once at the jail Deputy Robbie Lane, LCSO (a Spanish speaking deputy) attempted to read the implied consent law in English and Spanish, but Mr. Garcia would not cooperate and refused to listen without cursing other officers.

Rolando Esteban Lopez, 31, also of West 4th Avenue, Lenoir City was charged with public intoxication. He was a passenger in the Garcia vehicle.

Lopez reportedly had red bloodshot eyes and a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage

on his person. When the officer asked Mr. Lopez where he lived to possibly get him a ride home in his intoxicated state, Mr. Lopez could not remember. Deputy Michael Watkins LCSO made the arrest.

Elias Domingo Bartolome, 18, East 5th street, Crossville was charged with no drivers license, speeding and financial responsibility.

also was an unopened can of Bud Light in his shirt pocket.

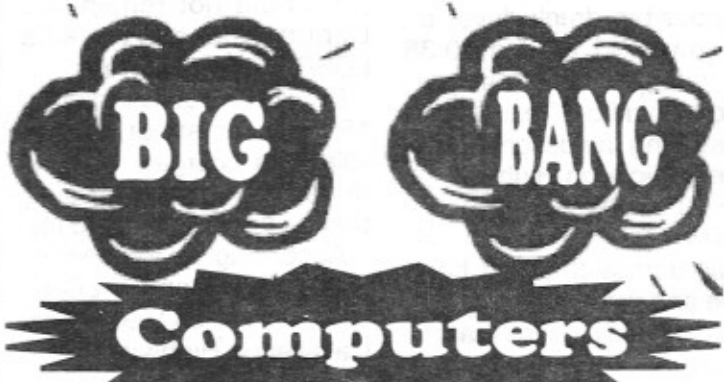
Mr. Carver reportedly advised his license are suspended for failure to satisfy a citation.

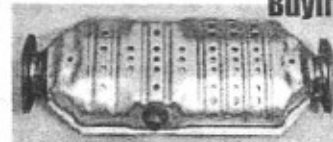

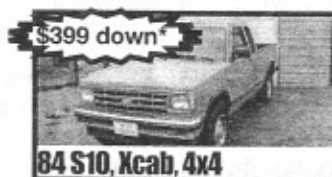
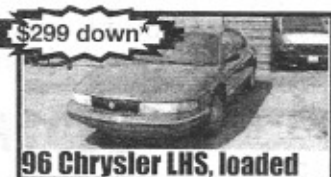
