A probation officer in Loudon County has been charged with driving under the influence after an accident on River Road where the responding officer arrived and found the probation

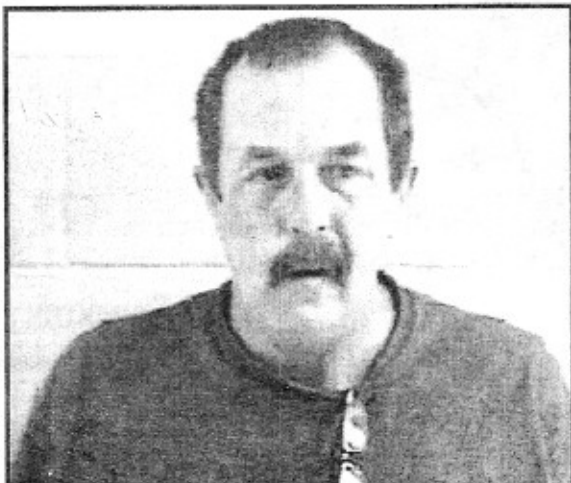
officer staggering beside his truck.

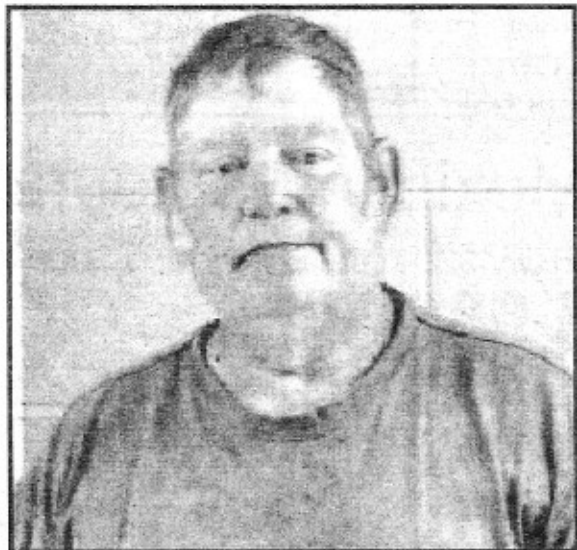

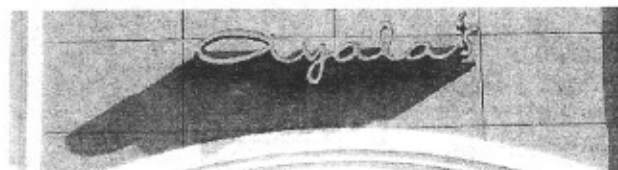

Roberts

William Albert 'Billy' Roberts, 56, Dutton Road, Loudon was taken into custody on a warrant for sexual battery.

According to the arrest warrant, on or about, May 20th, 2009 at approximately 5:30pm, a woman called 911 and advised, Mr. William Roberts aka Billy Roberts tried to rape her. Upon further investigation, a statement was taken from the victim. The victim stated she was in the truck with Mr. Roberts at approximately 4:00pm and asked to borrow \$200 from Roberts. The victim reported she thought Roberts was going to give the money to her when he took her home.

The victim further

reported Mr. Roberts pulled into a field on the way to her residence, and forced himself on her. According to the victim, Roberts tried to get her belt off and broke it in the process and he forced her shirt up and kissed her breast and mouth. The victim stated she told Roberts to stop and he finally did but was angry.

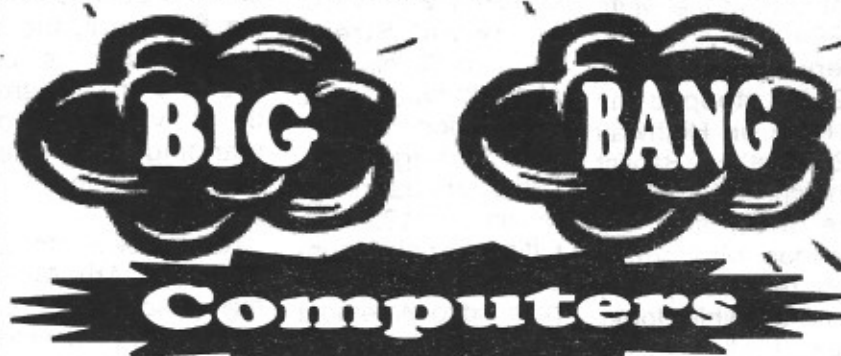
The field was located around a sharp curve on Pine Grove Providence Road in Loudon. Upon further investigation, bruising and red marks could be seen clearly on the victim. Photos were taken of the injuries and the broken belt was taken into evidence. Sgt. Detective Patrick Upton LCSO interviewed Mr. Roberts on tape. Roberts reportedly

admitted he did pull into the field and first denied even touching the woman. He was then confronted with possible evidence that could prove oth-

erwise, and then he allegedly admitted to touching the woman's belt and kissing her breasts.

Deputy Deland, LCSO, made the ar-

rest on Huffs Ferry Road on Thursday, May 21st, 2009 at 3:30pm, along with Investigator Sgt. Patrick Upton, and Lt. Jeff Vittatoe, LCSO CID.

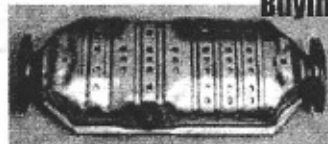

Brewster

Upon arrival, the officer observed a silver Chevy pickup that ran off the roadway into some bushes. A man, identified as Timothy F. Brewster, was allegedly staggering around beside the vehicle. He reportedly was very unsteady on his feet, bloodshot and watery eyes and a very slurred speech. Mr. Brewster allegedly advised officers

he had taken several Klonopin. He agreed to perform a series of field sobriety tasks, he did poorly on all tasks given. Brewster was placed under arrest and read the implied consent form, he agreed to a blood test, and was transported to Fort Loudoun ER for this test and then transported to the Loudon County Jail.

Jewelry stolen

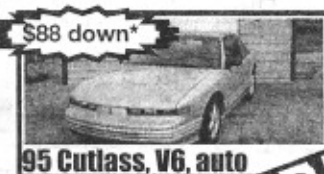
