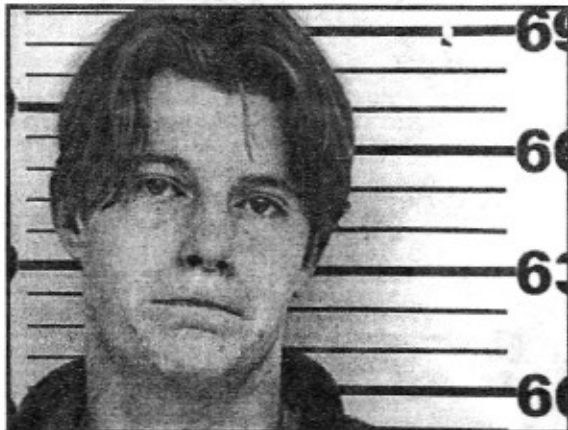

charged with open container, possession of drug paraphernalia and possession of schedule II cocaine.

According to records, early Friday morning at approximately 12:42 a.m., Officer F. Donth, LCPD responded to Highway 11 and Highway 321 in reference to a silver 1991 Toyota van sitting at the intersection with a white male asleep in the driver's seat.

Upon arrival the officer observed a man sitting in the driver's seat passed out at the wheel. He was later identified as Stephen Douglas Flynn.

Flynn reportedly had an open, half-drunk bottle of beer between his legs.

Officer Donth woke Flynn and asked him to step out of the van and when he did a small round metal pipe fell from his lap. It reportedly had burn residue on one end and when asked what it was used for, Mr. Flynn stated it's used for smoking crack.

Flynn was given roadside sobriety tasks and completed them successfully.

The officer asked if there were any drugs in the vehicle and Flynn replied, "No, not at all, go ahead and search it."

After waking up a passed out passenger and having her step out, Officer Donth located another pipe used for smoking cocaine. A piece of crack cocaine was also found in the vehicle.

A field test later showed it to be positive for cocaine.

Mr. Flynn allegedly stated he uses cocaine and smoked some recently. Stephen Flynn was placed into custody and his passenger called her uncle for a ride home.

stated her bank discovered numerous checks were used and

some were written out to individuals.

Mrs. Wilkerson advised her daughter who lives with her had a friend over at the house while Mrs. Wilkerson and her husband were out of town. The daughter was at the residence when the checks were stolen, according to her mother.

One of the checks was made out to a male subject in the amount of \$450 and another check was made out to a married couple in the amount of \$300. Both checks were cashed at ORNL in Oak Ridge on the

There were five more checks forged on the account as well.

The total amount of stolen forged checks was \$2830. A suspect was named in the case.

records, Sunday at approximately 2:11 a.m., Officer Bennie Houser, LPD was dispatched to a one vehicle accident on Commerce Street in front of the Loudon County Health Department. Upon arrival, the officer found a white Ford F-100 had hit a utility pole.

The truck was not occupied.

After running the tag, the registration came back to Timothy Estel Chudley. While Officer Houser was working the wreck, Officers Bill Evans and Jon Yates, LPD went to a residence on Poplar Street and found Mr. Chudley at home. He was brought back to the scene.

Mr. Chudley reportedly stated he'd been to the Shell on Highway 72 and bought a latte and on the way home he ran off the road and hit something, then walked home.

When asked why he didn't call and report the wreck Chudley stated he did not have a phone.

Chudley reportedly had slurred speech, was very unsteady on his feet and stated he had taken his xanax. He performed poorly on the field sobriety tasks he was given.

Chudley was read the implied consent and refused.

Approximately 20 to 25 minutes prior to being dispatched to the wreck, a clerk

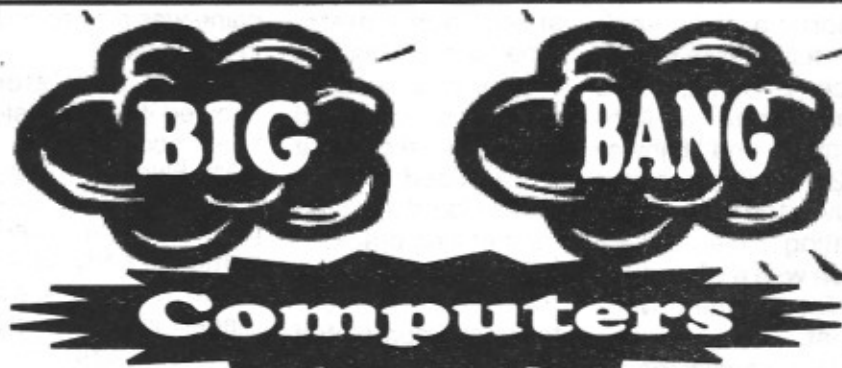
at a Highway 72 location had advised Officer Houser of a man with tattoo sleeves on both arms driving a white older model Ford pick-up
