## Man shoots wife, charged with attempted 1st degree murder

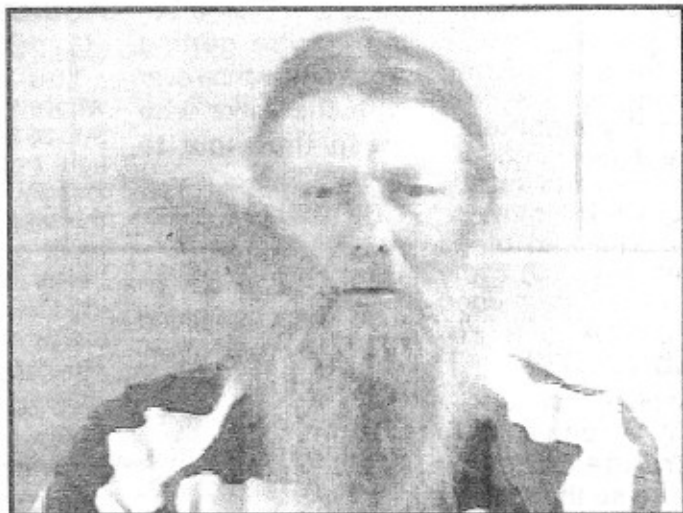
Loudon County Sheriff Tim Guider announced the arrest of Michael E. Brown, 48, of 14420 Beal's Chapel Road, Lenoir City for attempted 1st Degree Murder.

Sheriff Guider stated that at approximately 1:52 a.m. on July 5, 2009 deputies were dispatched to 14420 Beal's Chapel Road on a domestic shooting. Upon arrival, deputies learned

the victim, Faye Brown of the same address had already been transported to Ft. Loudon Hospital. Upon further investigation by deputies and the Criminal Investigation Division (CID), Michael Brown admitted at the residence he shot Mrs. Brown in the head area with a .22 caliber rifle.

A search warrant was issued and executed by CID and a .22 caliber rifle and one spent cartridge were among the
