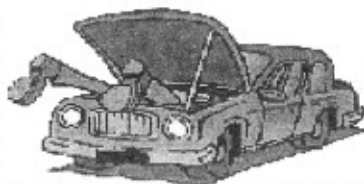

"This is the first fatality in the history of Bowen En-

The woman advised when she called the

number, "Mr. King" wanted personal ID numbers and checking or credit card numbers, however, she did not give him any information and told him she had no checking account.

The man advised her to go open a checking account, deposit \$10 into it and they would wire \$50,000 to the ac-

count, then she would need to send them a check for \$18,000 in the mail for taxes on her winnings.

The alleged company stated they were out of California but the caller ID showed Kingston, CB (Jamaica).

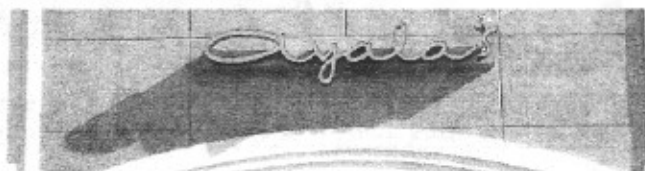
