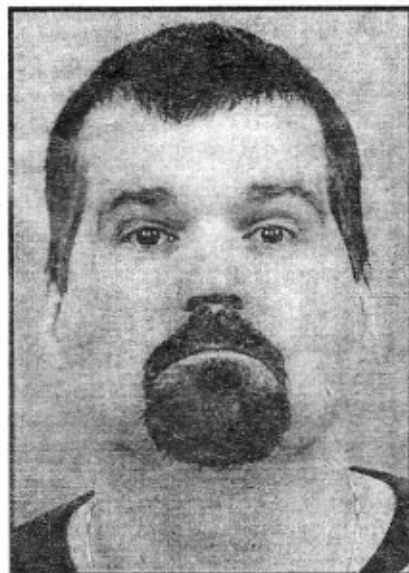

## Schaffner

The FBI, through its partnership with Lamar Outdoor Advertising and Outdoor Advertising Association of Georgia, was able to identify Schaffner as a direct result of the billboard initiative.

"This case is an emblematic example of the importance of public/private sector alliances in bringing criminals to justice in today's information age," said Richard Lambert, Special Agent in Charge of the FBI's Knoxville Division. "Working together with Lamar Outdoor Advertising and other electronic billboard owners, we now have the capability to instantly display a wanted suspect's

face to thousands of motorists throughout several states."

Schaffner is considered armed and dangerous and anyone with information regarding Schaffner's whereabouts should contact the FBI or their local law enforcement office.

Schaffner is described as a white male, 36 years old, 6' tall, 200 pound, with brown hair and brown eyes.

Additionally, he may be driving a 1994 GMC Jimmy pickup truck, black in color with Tennessee license plate 360 WLN or a 1994 Chevrolet S10 pickup, red in color with South Carolina license plate EVE 177.

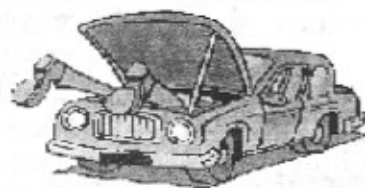

Upon arrival the officer entered the residence to find a woman in the rear bedroom where one of the assaults had taken place. The woman stated that Mr. Young choked her and she called her son. Her son then came to the residence to check on his mother, finding her on the back porch and at that time Mr. Young is reported to have stuck a pump shotgun out the back door pointing it at the woman's son and attempting to chamber a cartridge into the weapon.

Upon doing this

the woman grabbed the weapon and it discharged shooting a hole in the porch screen. Young then pointed the weapon at the son again and told him to leave the property. The then left the property, going to his residence and calling police.

Mr. Young entered the bedroom thinking that the woman was hiding in the closet and fired the weapon through the closet

door causing damage.

Mr. Young then took the weapon and placed it in a vehicle parked in the rear of the home.

Upon police arrival

they asked Mr. Young if he had been shooting a gun and he admitted he fired the weapon.

Kevin Brian Young, 55, of River Road, Loudon, was charged

with two counts of aggravated domestic assault and assault by domestic violence.

Officer Jim Thearp, LPD made the arrest.

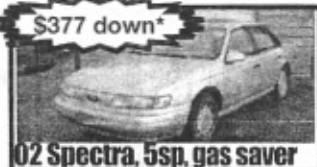

from the vehicle. The officer made contact with the driver, identified as Tamara A. Johnson.

Johnson had red bloodshot eyes and slurred speech. The officer asked Johnson

to exit the vehicle and she could not stand without holding onto the vehicle and she was very unsteady on her feet.

Johnson was asked to perform sobriety tasks and she was very uncooperative and would not per-

form the tasks. After being placed under arrest for DUI Johnson became combative and tried to resist officers by fighting being put in the patrol car. While putting Johnson in the patrol car she was very belligerent and combative and had to be restrained in the vehicle.

According to reports, Monday at around 4:33 p.m., Deputy Chris Jenkins, LCSO responded to the POA Office in Tellico Village to a verbal assault. Before he arrived at the center, the officer received information from dispatch the altercation

became physical.

Upon arrival in the area, Deputy Jenkins made contact with both parties involved in the altercation inside an office.

On receiving written statements from several witnesses at the office and from the victim and observing evidence in the office and physical evidence on the man's arm, it was believed Mr. Angelo P. Leone was the primary aggressor in the altercation.

Mr. Leone allegedly went to the POA Office and intentionally, knowingly, and recklessly caused bodily harm and contact to the other man, which

was extremely offensive and provocative.

Also, Mr. Leone's actions were intentionally, knowingly and recklessly offensive and provocative to the office's other employees, causing reasonable fear of imminent bodily injury.
