Zachary Dukes, 18, Trailview Drive Loudon, was charged with Vandalism. Corporal Rondel M. Branam, was dispatched to Peachtree Street in Loudon, TN in reference to a possible vandalism. Upon speaking to the home owner, he stated that his wife told him their front storm door was shattered. When the wife went to see what happened she observed two young males standing across from her house. The males were described as white males one wearing an orange hoody and one wearing a black hoody. When the female yelled at the boys and told them she was calling the police she advised they then took off running toward a residence in the area. The storm door appeared to have been shattered

by a small diametered projectile. Deputy did respond to the residence where they ran to and made contact with Mr. Zachery Dukes and a juvenile male.
