The mayor has held this job throughout his term of office and works both his private sector job and performs his duties as mayor out of his city hall office. Investigators noted the mayor is frequently out of town and unavailable town employees during the day.

investigation The also found the town of Oakland entered into business with a private company to upgrade the town's information systems. The company charged the town \$52,172.29 over a ten month period. It appears the company was directed to invoice the town in a manner that would help circumvent the town's purchasing policies. 




