found him very agitated and hard to deal with. He also had been drinking alcohol.

The two parties have been together for 7 years and have two children together which were present. Given the defendants acts of aggression, vandalism and intoxication, Officer found him to be the primary aggressor and placed him under arrest. He was transported to jail.
