

Fraudulent Scheme Costs City of Decherd More Than \$210,000

Tennessee The Comptroller's Office, working in conjunction with the 12th Judicial District Attorney's criminal investigator, has revealed that the City of Decherd's former water and sewer superintendent and a local business owner engaged in a fraudulent billing and kickscheme that back cost the city at least

\$210,774.

City officials first identified questionable activity and brought their concerns to the Comptroller's Office and District Attorney's office.

Investigators found that during the period January 2012 through August 2014, former superintendent James Wesley Parks assist-Poultry Electric Hardware owner (see Fraud pg. 4)

acknowledged scheme and claimed that Frame shared the proceeds from this arrangement with Parks and another former city employee. Purchases from Poultry Electric and Hardware sometimes exceeded \$30,000 in a single month.

investigative The includes exreport amples and exhibits depicting fraudulent invoices for work that was never performed and fictitious products that were never received by the city.

In September 2017, James Wesley Parks was indicted by the Franklin County Grand Jury on one count of theft over \$60,000. Jeff Frame

was also indicted by Jeff Frame in creat- the Franklin Couning fraudulent invoic- ty Grand Jury on one es to the city totaling count of theft over \$60,000.

"As with so many of these cases, a significant problem within the City of Decherd allowed this scheme James Wesley Parks superintendent was the solely responsible for ordering and approving the purchases from Poultry Electric and Hardware. These responsibilities should be separated."

> City officials have indicated they have corrected or intend to correct these deficiencies.


