container was (2) baggies with Crystal Methamphetamine (9.0 Grams). Also found in Ms. Vaulton's purse was (35) white pills with imprint Z70 (Metformin 500 mg), (8) small baggies, (2) cut straws, and digital scales.

**Haslam Announces Reward in Bristol Homicide**

\$5,000 offered in 2017 murder of Michael Heatherly

Tennessee Gov. Bill Haslam today announced a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the apprehension, arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the September murder of Michael Heatherly.

"We ask anyone with knowledge of the case to come forward to help bring to justice whoever is responsible for this crime," Haslam said.

Heatherly was shot in a Walmart parking lot in Bristol, Tennessee. He worked as a vendor for Walmart and was headed to his

vehicle after completing his work duties. Authorities believe he was shot by someone in a vehicle in an adjacent space in the parking lot.

Sullivan County District Attorney General Barry Staubus requested the reward from the governor to help generate leads in this unsolved case.

**Haslam Reauthorizes Reward in Lorenzen Wright Homicide**

Up to \$10,000 offered in 2010 murder of former NBA player

Tennessee Gov. Bill Haslam today announced the state will re-issue a \$5,000 reward and match for information leading to the apprehension, arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the homicide of Lorenzen Wright.

"In addition to the recent discovery of the murder weapon, we believe someone has information that could help solve this case," Haslam said. "We ask anyone with knowledge of the case to come forward to help bring to justice whoever is responsible for this crime."

Wright's body was discovered on July 28, 2010, in southeast Shelby County. He played college basketball at the University of Memphis and was

a former NBA player with the Memphis Grizzlies.

The state will match up to an additional \$5,000 if any other organization offers a reward.

Shelby County District Attorney General Amy Weirich requested that the reward from the governor be re-issued. Haslam first issued the reward on September 19, 2011,

but no offender had been apprehended within the statutory five-year timeline.
