Due to finding the pill in the floor board the vehicle was searched and inside a L&M cigarette pack was a clear cellophane wrapper with a clear crystal type substance believed to be Methamphetamine and the substance did field test positive for Methamphetamine. in the cigarette pack was 4 green round pills with markings V4811 believed to be Oxycodone Hydrochloride 15mg. Also in the L&M cigarette pack was a red cut straw commonly used to ingest illegal narcotics. Mr. Dehart was then placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon Co., jail. End of report.
