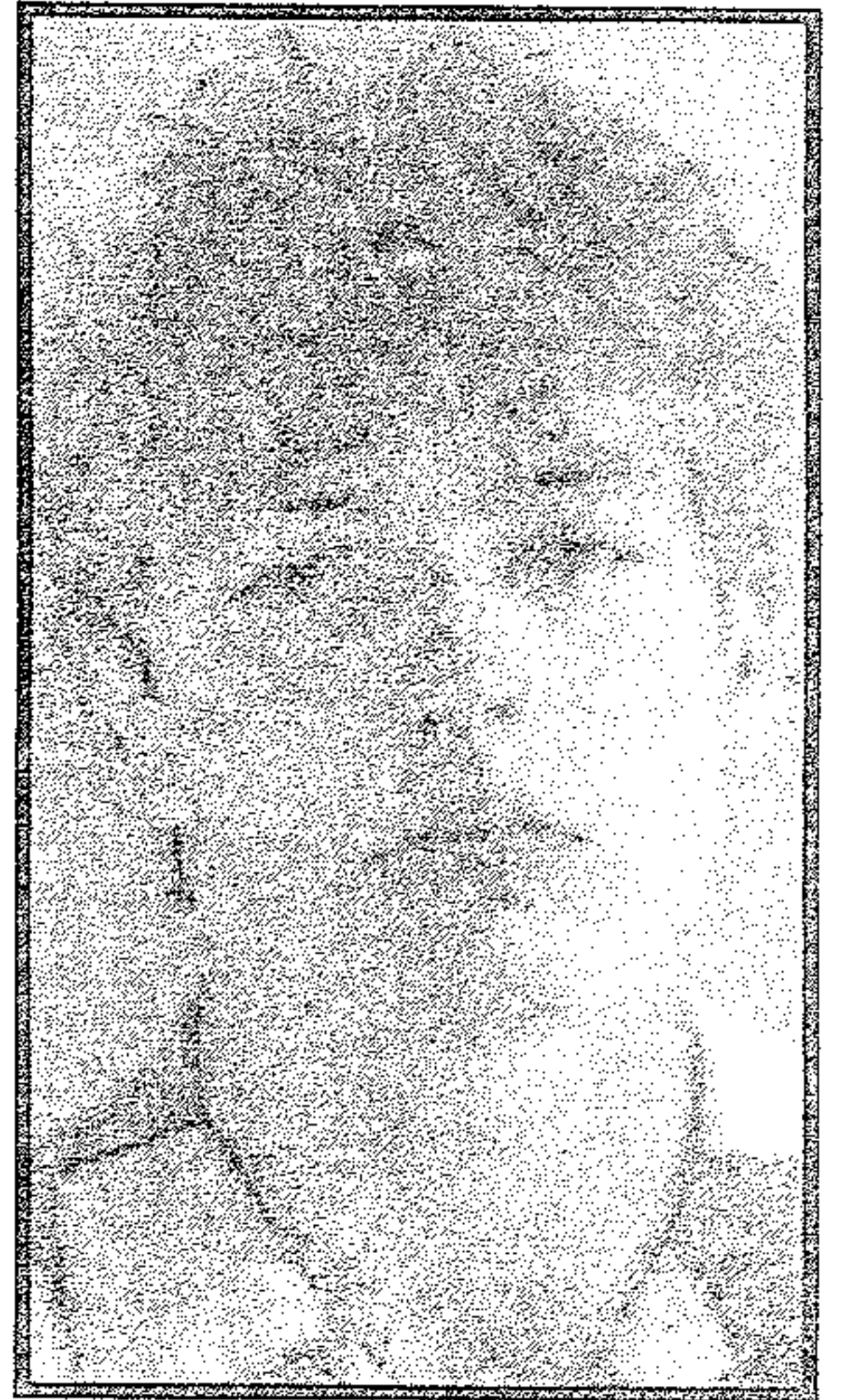

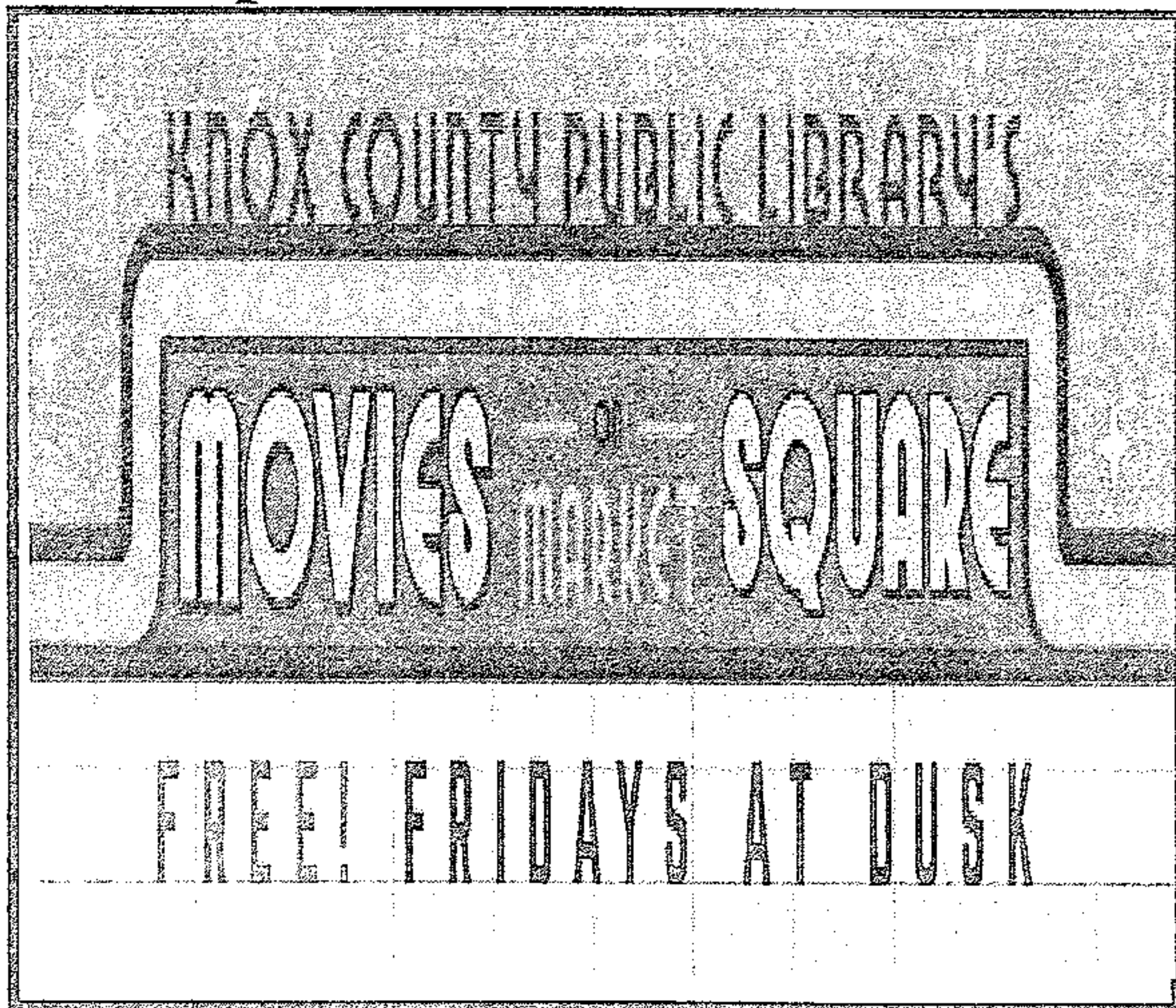

Dallas Officials Lined Pockets with Proceeds from Stop-Arm Bus Cameras

Several years ago, the school transportation provider in Dallas added stop-arm cameras to their school buses to keep students safer and bring in revenue from traffic tickets.

Taxpayers ended

up paying millions of dollars for the cameras—but they brought in little revenue.

The school transportation provider continued to buy the cameras because the camera company

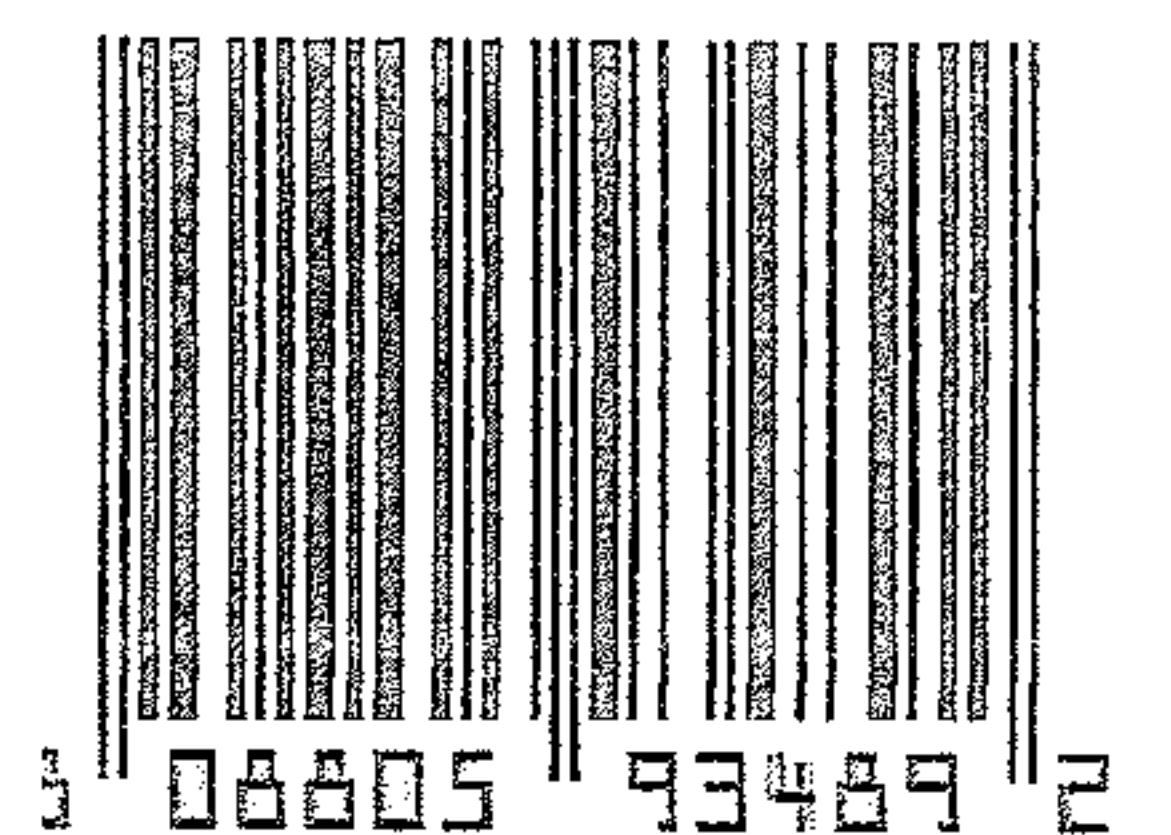

on a wooden 2 x 4 were two more baggies of Methamphetamine. The total amount of Methamphetamine recovered was approximately 7.95



grams. Found behind some foam in the wall was a green baggy with approximately 1.1 grams Heroin/Fentanyl. Found in a blender under Jimmy Coffman's desk was approximate 1.69 grams of a grinded up powder tentatively identified as Gabapentin, a Sch V narcotic. Found in a microwave were 2 pill bottles. One pill bottle

was prescribed to Kimberly Norman and contained 15 Oxycodone with imprint RP 15, Sch II. The other pill bottle contained 14 white pills with imprint G76 (Oxymorphone 15 Mg) Sch II, 4 orange pills with imprint M N8 (Sublingual) Sch III, 3 blue pills with imprint R031 (Alprazolam 1 Mg) Sch IV, 11.5 peach pills with imprint 153 (Sublingual

8 mg) Sch III, and 1/2 white pill with imprint 54411 (Suboxone 8 mg) Sch III. All the pills listed above were not in the proper prescription bottles and Coffman did not produce valid scripts for them. Also found were multiple items of drug paraphernalia, syringes, baggies, scales, pipe, and drug ledger. Jimmy Coffman was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail. This did happen in Loudon County.

Evade

Brooke Jordan, 19, Grove Street Loudon, was charged with Evading Arrest, Driving on Revoked/Suspended License, Simple Possession, and Speeding 21 mph over limit. from Deputy. Deputy then detained Peyton and attempted to place him in the back of the cruiser for Deputy safety. lined the pockets of multiple public officials. And as a result of an FBI and Internal Revenue Service investigation, those involved in the scheme are now serving prison sentences.

Robert Leonard Jr., CEO of the company that manufactured the cameras, paid several bribes to benefit his company, including \$450,000 in multiple cash payments, trips, and other gifts to Dallas City Councilman Dwaine Caraway. In exchange, Caraway cast votes on the council in favor of the cameras.

ordinance to ticket drivers who were caught passing the camera," said Special Agent Erik Tighe, who investigated this case out of the FBI's Dallas Field Office. "Caraway was instrumental in making that ordinance happen. He accepted bribes to continue the program."

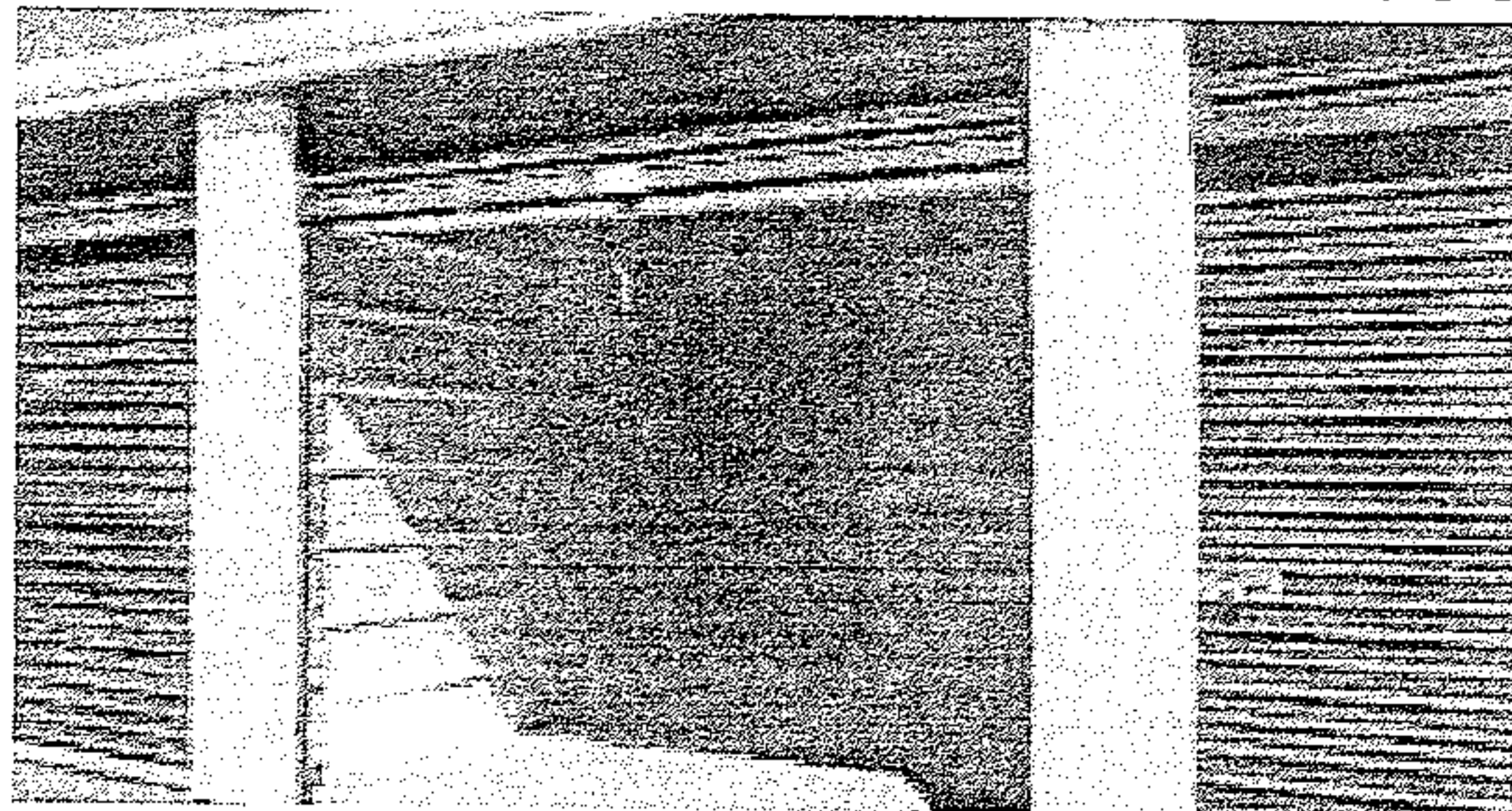

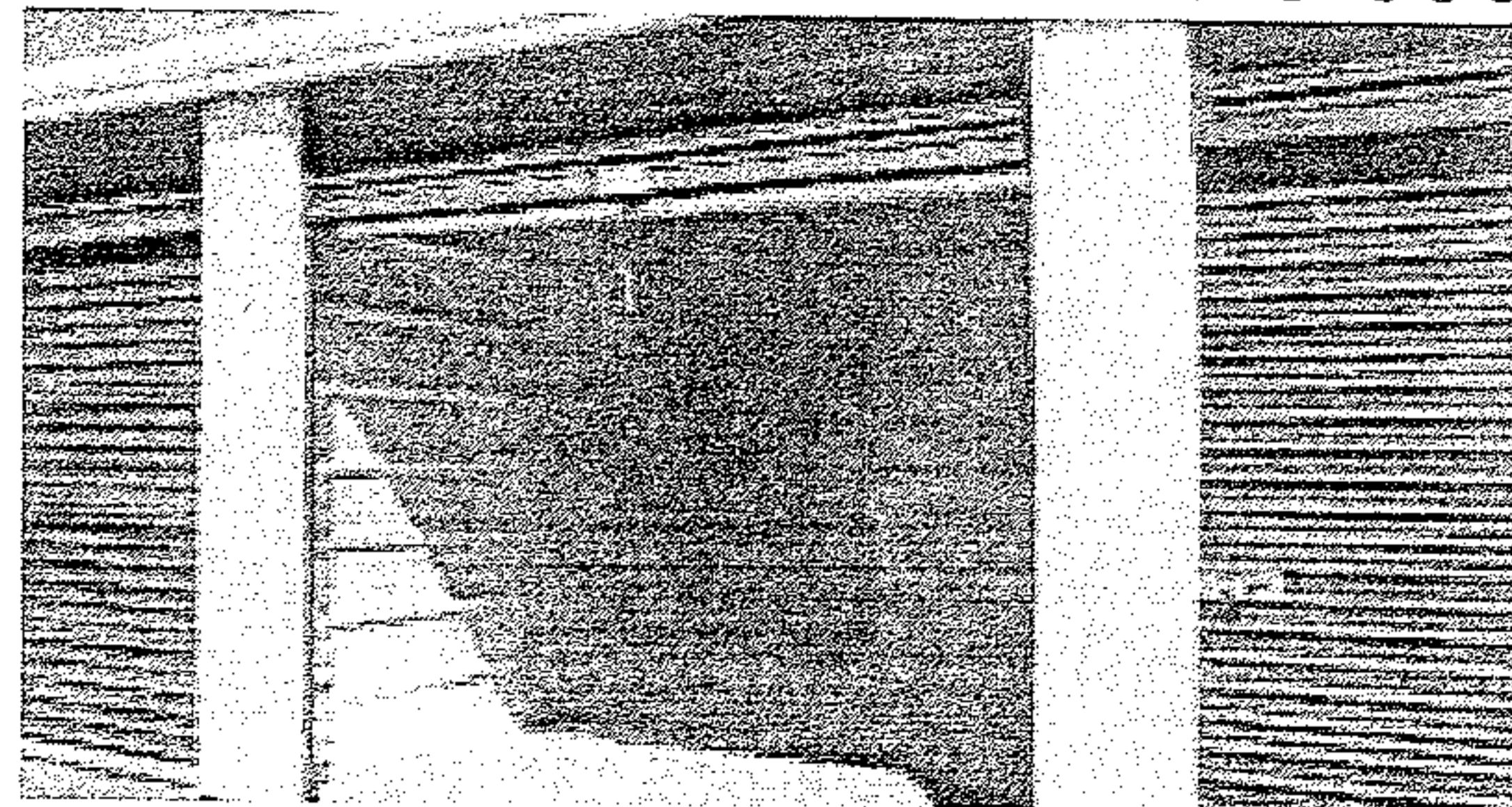

Assault

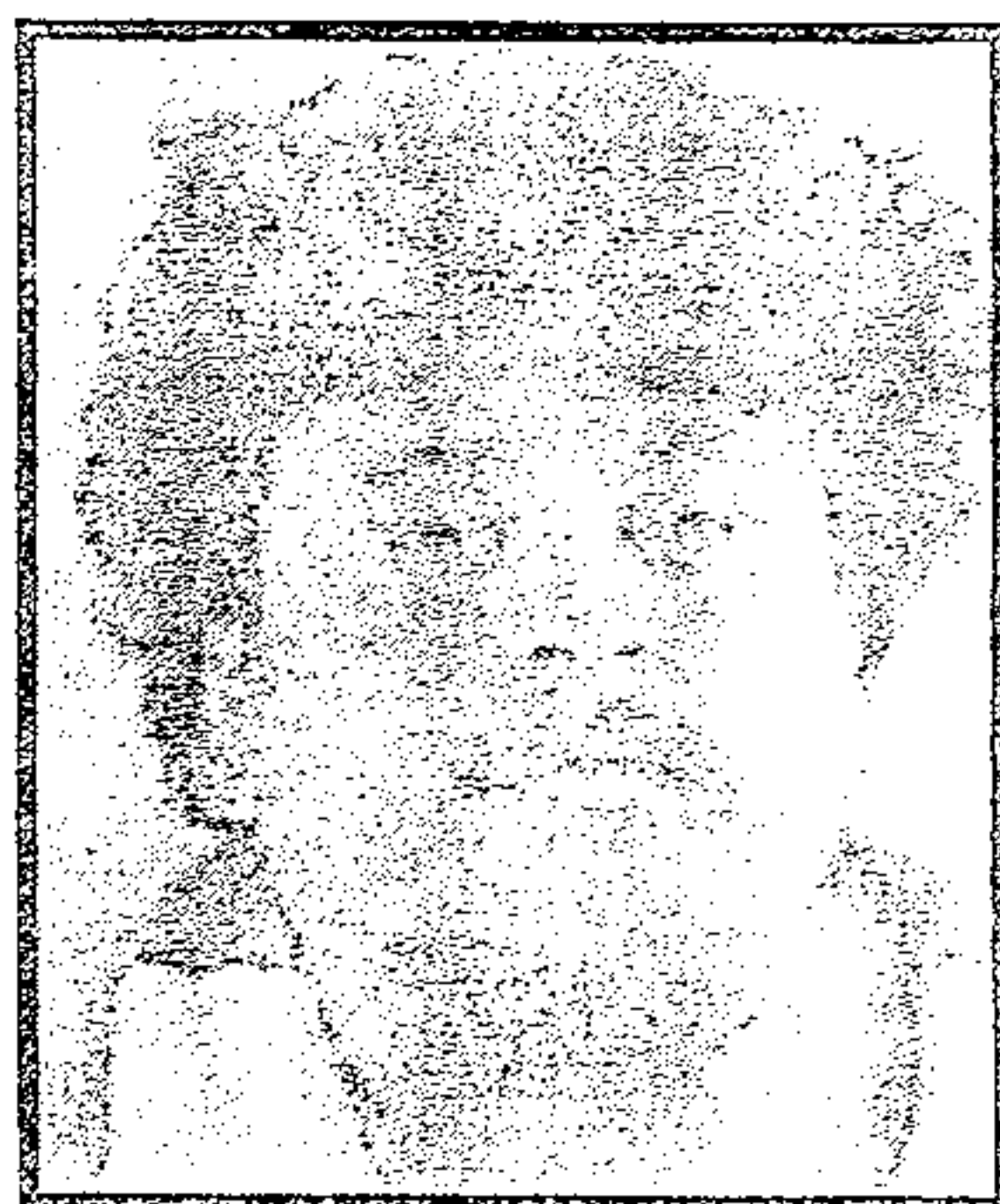


Man charged with assault after breaking into victims home
