
7. The Court therefore finds that a temporary injunction should issue ordering the Plaintiff to block access to the walking trail in the area of the slope until the Defendant corrects the slope or the Plaintiff provides a barrier on its land.

8. Once corrective measures have been taken by either party, a hearing will be conducted by the Court to determine if the injunction should be dissolved.


9. Defendant shall file an injunction bond in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Plaintiff is enjoined from permitting access to the walking trail commonly known as the Towncreek Greenway in the area of the slope until further order of this Court.


