RESCILUTION NO. 2016-10-24-2146

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AS A FULL-TIME POSITION IN LENOIR CITY, TENNESSEE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lenoir City has experienced rapid growth over the past years, and continues to experience such growth; and

WHEREAS, a growing and thriving community requires more time and attention from the leadership provided by the Office of Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the act of officially establishing the Office of Mayor as a full-time position would meet the increased demands of time and attention; and

WHEREAS, the powers and duties given to the full-time Mayor shall be the same as that set forth in Article V, Section 1 ("Duties and Powers of the Mayor") of the Charter of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee, which is hereto attached; and

WHEREAS, the action shall require two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of City Council for passage and shall require two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of City Council for rescission; and

WHEREAS, the salary of the full-time office shall be set by the Budget Committee of Lenoir City; and

WHEREAS, whomever holds the full-time office shall not be permitted to hold another full-time position while in such capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Office of Mayor is hereby established as a full-time position in Lenoir City, Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective on the 1st day of January, 2017.
