A true bill means there was enough evidence to allow for a trial by jury. A no bill means there was not enough evidence for a case. A resubmittal is a case that has been presented again to the Grand Jury. A continued on bound over means the case will be presented at a later date. A scheduled to plea by information means the defendant intends to plead to the charges they have been given.

There are also sealed indictment which are not contained on the report. Those indictments are not made public until the suspect has been taken into custody and charged with the indictment. All those charged are presumed innocent until proven guilty in court.

"One of the biggest evolutions for NSAF was making it publicly available," said Colleen Childers of the FBI's Art Crime Program. "Now, with the new mobile upgrade that we've undergone, we want to continue to push to make it a more user-friendly platform."

While the app was primarily created with law enforcement and art-industry partners in mind, anyone can use it to verify that art or antiquities they own or are looking to buy aren't actually stolen property.

In the app, you can: Search and filter stolen art by location, description, type of art, and more.

Display the information most relevant to you.

Save pieces of art to a favorites page and easily access them later.

Share stolen art entries via text, email, or social media.

Submit tips to the FBI directly from the app.

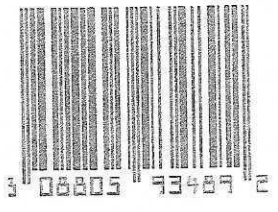

Salvador Zavala-Cuevas, 50, WHISONANT ST South Carolina, was charged with DUI, Traffic Control Device, Financial Responsibility, Driving on roadways Laned for Traffic, License Required.

Officer Wilkes LCPD, was notified by Sgt. Butler regarding a possibly intoxicated driver. Officer was told that the vehicle was a Ford F-150 traveling on Old Hwy 95. While traveling on Kingston St, Deputy observed the vehicle to be traveling at a high rate of speed, and completely in the opposite lane of travel. Officer activated my lights and sirens and went after the truck. Officer caught up to the vehicle, bearing SC tag 5694QN, at the intersection of Kingston St and 2nd Ave. The vehicle continued on to Broadway St, disregarding the red light and making a

right turn. The truck stopped at Broadway and C St. After approaching the vehicle and asking the driver, identified as Salvador Zavala-Cuevas, to step out of the vehicle, Officer observed the male to be unsteady on his feet and the odor of alcohol omitting from him. When the offender was questioned about drinking, he stated that he drank a beer 20 minutes ago while driving. Officer did observe him to have bloodshot and glossy eyes. The offender was asked to perform SFST's, to which he agreed. During HGN, Officer observed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. During the Walk and Turn, while giving instructions Officer observed the offender not being able to maintain his balance. During the walking phase, Officer observed the offender to miss

multiple heel-to-toe steps, step off of the line, and use his arms for balance. While performing the test, the offender began to fall over. At that time, it was determined that the offender could not continue SFST's for his own safety. He was placed into my

custody and then read the TN Implied Consent Form, to which he agreed to provide a blood sample. The offender was transported to the FLMC for a blood draw, and was then transported to the Loudon County Jail without further incident.

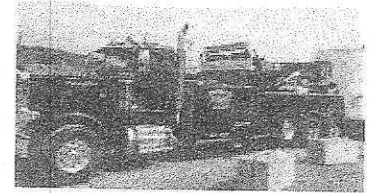
