An investigation by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office has resulted in the indictment of Allyson Palmer, the former Early Learning Coordinator for the Paris Special School District (PSSD) in Henry County.

Investigators determined that Palmer misappropriated at least \$7,383.47 from both the PSSD and the W.G. Rhea Elementary School parent teacher organization

(PTO). These stolen amounts include the following:

Palmer used her district-issued Walmart credit card to make unauthorized personal purchases totaling \$6,226.47. These included items such as cosmetic products, holiday gift wrap, gift cards, energy drink mixes, and outdoor goods.

Palmer also misappropriated \$1,157 in PTO fundraising collection after the PTO

sold lunches during the annual Paris Fish Fry. Video footage from the school showed Palmer entering the school secretary's office and using a key to unlock a drawer containing the PTO collection envelopes.

Additionally, investigators identified \$404.71 in other questionable purchases made by Palmer that were either not sup-

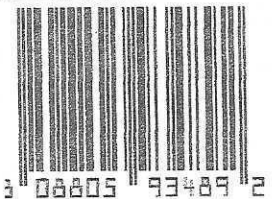
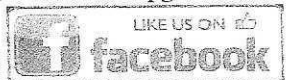

William Brooks, 29, Willington Manor Loudon, was charged with DUI, Violation of Implied consent, Evading Arrest, and Poss. of Handgun while under the Influence.

Officer Padgett LPD, was responding to assist FTO Ben Everett and FTO Trey Clemmer at Hwy 72 N. (Exxon Gas Station) on a possible Unwanted Belligerent Male subject trying to purchase Alcoholic Beverages. Officer Everett advised the subject left in a white car possibly heading South on Hwy 72, Officer observed a white Chevy sedan pass him at Hwy 72 @ Butterscotch. The officer turned around and observed the vehicle pass

another vehicle in the middle lane of travel, the officer activated his emergency equipment on My patrol vehicle and the White Chevy did not stop.

Gary Hamblin, 73, Rudd Road Greenback, was charged with Aggravated Assault x2.

Deputy Kirkland, was at the Loudon County Sheriff's Office when he was flagged down by victim 1. The victim stated she was at her home at Rudd Rd when her husband, Gary Hamblin, became aggressive towards her. The victim 1 stated her husband is very manipulative and has severe health problems so he is very careless and angry about his condition. Victim 1 stated that her husband had pinned her down on the couch and was in her face and would not let her up, victim 1 also stated Gary said he was going to shoot her and then kill himself. At this point, victim 1 and Gary's son, victim 2, came into the

room and pushed Gary off of victim. Victim 2 said that Gary then swung at him, and then victim 2 ducked and shoved him back by the throat. Victim 2 was acting in defense of his mother and himself. Gary left the room and then retrieved a handgun and sat in the living room. Victim 2 went into the room where his father was and saw the firearm and asked "Are you going to shoot me?" and victim 2 stated that his father said, "I'm tempted to." This placed both victims in fear for their lives due to the threats that Gary has made. Deputy spoke to both victims at different times and their stories were almost identical. Deputy also spoke to a witness who further corroborated their stories. Deputy advised the victims and witness on how to obtain an order of protection.

Allyson Palmer resigned from the PSSD on June 15, 2022. Based on this investigation, in July 2023, she was indicted by the Henry County Grand Jury for one count of theft of property over \$2,500, one count of fraudulent use of a credit card over \$2,500, and one count of official misconduct.

“Credit card purchases should be reconciled with the monthly statements and reviewed carefully,” said Comptroller Mumpower. “In this case, administrative staff failed to match or compare receipts to the monthly credit card statements or review the charges for appropriateness before paying the bill.”

Fortino Salazar, 42, Dailey Avenue Loudon, was charged with Domestic Assault.

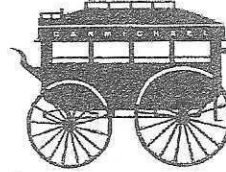

Police beat

Alex Crawford, 21, Vonore Road Loudon, was charged with DUI, Poss. of Handgun while Under the Influence, and Violation of Implied Consent.

Officer Law LCPD, was on routine patrol when the officer observed a black Chevrolet Silverado (TN Tag BJB-1473) driving down the middle of Highway 321. Upon conducting a traffic stop at 390 Highway 321 North (Weigel's), Officer identified the driver to be Alex Crawford. While speaking to Mr. Crawford the officer observed him to have the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his persons, blood shot watery eyes, and a thick tongue. Mr. Crawford stated he had a few beers prior to our encounter at the Cotton eyed Joes in Knoxville. Mr. Crawford consented to SFST, when Mr. Crawford exited the vehicle, the officer observed a half drank Michelob Ultra 12 ounce, and a fully drank Miller Lite 12 ounce in the door. While conducting HGN, the officer observed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and an onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both of Crawford's eyes. During the walk and turn, Mr. Crawford started the test twice before being instructed to do so. During the one leg stand, Mr. Crawford did not follow directions on how to elevate his foot. Mr. Crawford performed poorly on all tests given and was placed under arrest for DUI. After placing him under arrest, he was read the Tennessee Blood and/or Breath Consent Advisement. After reading the consequences, Mr. Crawford refused to submit a blood sample to determine his blood alcohol content. While conducting an inventory of the vehicle, a black Canik 9mm pistol was in the center console. Mr. Crawford was then transported to the Loudon County Jail without incident. All the above occurred in Lenoir City, TN.

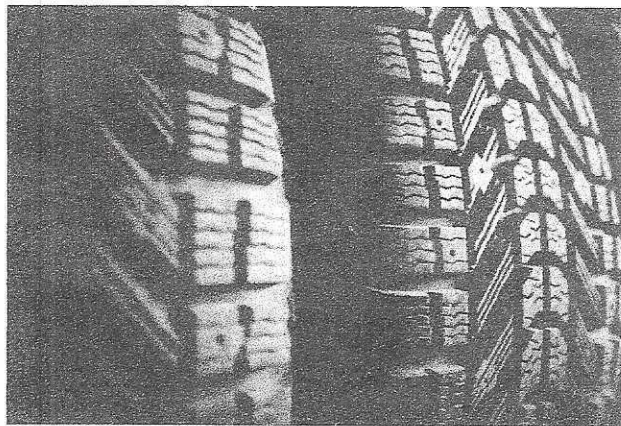
